### Directions:

#### From North/South of Boston:

Take I-128 to Mass Pike (I90)/W. From the Pike, take Exit 6 for I-291 (Springfield/Hartford). At traffic light, turn left onto I-291/W. Take Exit 3 for Armory St. Take first left. At blinking red light, turn right onto Armory St. continue to first traffic light. Turn left onto Carew St. Mercy Medical Center (MMC) is ½ mile on left.

#### From West of Springfield:

Take Mass Pike (I-90)/E. to Exit 6 for I-291 (Springfield/Hartford). At traffic light, turn left onto I-291. Take Exit 3 for Armory St. Take first left. At blinking red light, turn right onto Armory St. continue to first traffic light. Turn left onto Carew St. MMC is ½ mile on left.

#### From South of Springfield:

Take I-91/N to Exit 8 for I-291/20E. Take first exit, 2B/Dwight St. Turn left at stop sign onto Dwight St. At second traffic light, turn right onto Carew St. MMC is ½ mile on right.

#### From North of Springfield:

Take I-91/S to Exit 8 for I-291/20E. Take Exit 3/Armory St. Go through traffic light. Follow rotary around to the left. At blinking red light, turn right onto Armory St. to first traffic light. Left onto Carew St. MMC is ½ mile on left.

Parking: Lot 15

Use Physician's Office Center entrance. Take elevator (behind information booth) to ground floor. After exiting elevator, turn right and then take left at corridor to Medical Staff Room.
